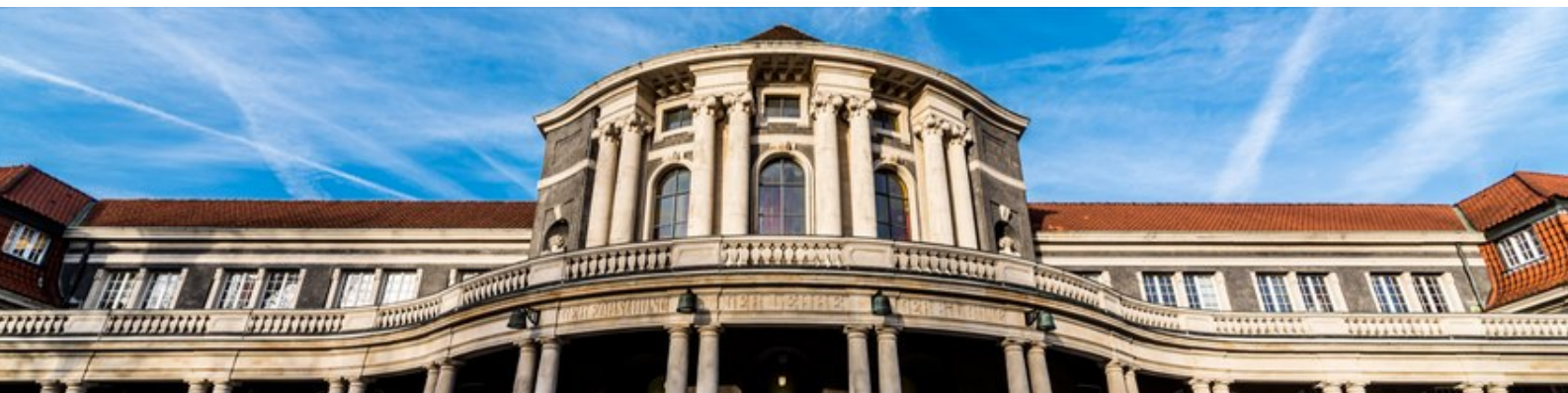

Responsibilities:

The professorship is responsible for teaching music instruction. Their duties include teacher training for primary schools, secondary schools, and special needs education, including the preparation and supervision of teaching placements. Duties also include conducting research in relevant fields of music didactics and participation in the faculty’s internationalization and knowledge exchange activities.

Applicants are also expected to participate in one of the faculty’s major research areas, either Literacy in Diversity Settings or Uncertainty as a Dimension of Education (<https://www.ew.uni-hamburg.de/forschung/forschungslandkarte.html>). The application should indicate to which of these research areas their research can best be assigned.

Participation is also desired in the University’s new and existing collaborative projects (<https://www.uni-hamburg.de/en/forschung/forschungsprofil/forschungsschwerpunkte.html>).

Section 12 subsection 7 sentence 2 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) applies.

Requirements:

Academic qualifications and additional requirements as specified in Section 15 HmbHG.

Additional Criteria:

Applicants are expected to have international research experience as well as a successful track record in acquiring external funding and carrying out externally funded projects.

The University places particular emphasis on the quality of teaching and therefore requests that applicants provide details of their teaching experience and objectives.

Non-German-speaking post holders are expected to acquire the language skills necessary to teach in German (level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) within 2 years of commencing employment.

In accordance with Section 14 subsection 3 sentence 3 HmbHG, Universität Hamburg seeks to increase the proportion of women in teaching and research and encourages female academics to apply.

Severely disabled and disabled applicants with the same status will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.
